

New Wooster Javelin™

● The new Wooster Javelin™ makes tough sanding jobs much easier.

Most people who are sanding use what's commonly available today—a wooden pole with a metal tip on it. The wood pole is not really that comfortable to hold during the job. There's also a weakness where the metal tip meets the wood handle. Sometimes the tip breaks off, especially when it's necessary to work aggressively.

The new Wooster Javelin™ is unique as a sanding handle in three ways. No. 1, it's not round like a wood pole. Made of strong but lightweight aluminum with one smooth, flat side, it's shaped in a way that your thumb fits on the handle very comfortably. No. 2, unlike a wooden pole, the Javelin has a very comfortable textured grip at the bottom that gives painters excellent leverage when they're sanding. No. 3, the Javelin eliminates the weak spot near the tip of most sanding poles, so you can rely on its strength and durability.

The same Grip Tip™ as the other Sherlock GT® poles allows the Javelin to be used best with Wooster professional tools. These tools have a black GT insert that gives them the no-twist, easy-to-switch connection. The Javelin works with standard threaded tools too, by adding the R042 conversion tip.

So if the painter attaches a conversion tip to the bottom of his sander, it allows him to change out tools on the Javelin very quickly—almost eight times faster than a normal screw-on system. That is a true time-saver, because painters use pole sanders daily.

Our GT system is an added advantage to any painter who has many tools on the job, because time is money. Painters often glue the R042 conversion tip in their threaded tools permanently.

What you have in the Javelin is a unique tool, unlike anything else on the market. It can be used for all 4-foot pole jobs—rolling walls, doing sanding jobs, scrubbing motor homes—and additionally, when you get to a situation where your Sherlock GT 8- to 16-foot pole will not quite reach the ceiling, this little unique critter gives painters the advantage of another four feet!

The grip end of the Javelin has a ramp feature that lets it easily clip onto any Wooster Sherlock GT pole. The connection is very secure, without any slips or turns. Attached to the 16-foot GT, this can provide 20 feet of reach.

When it comes to merchandising, the Javelin is an excellent addition to any pole display. It's exceptionally good in the Wooster R855 Sherlock GT Convertible satellite. You could also cross-merchandise it with quick-dry mud or sanding tools. The Javelin has a flag tag that helps customers figure

out what the tool is and makes it attractive to painters.
